



## Pump House Brewery

The Pump House Brewery started over 20 years ago when Shaun Fraser and his wife Lilia opened a small brewpub in Moncton, New Brunswick. Named for Shaun's time as a firefighter with the Moncton Fire Department, the Pump House Brewery quickly became a favourite among locals. A year after opening, they launched the Blueberry Ale as a seasonal offering but it was such a hit that they brought it into regular rotation and haven't stopped brewing it since. In 2016, the brewery found huge success with the Crafty Radler. The Crafty Radler has now won multiple gold medals and is considered a favourite across Canada. What began as a small brewpub is now the largest microbrewery in Eastern Canada and distributes beer across all of Canada and into some parts of the US and UK.
